Thank you very much for choosing Camping Caravaning Suffolk @ Coopers Farm, Lawshall, an adult only farm stay site, for your next holiday in lovely rural Suffolk.

We are **Janet van Dam** (site manager) **and Ray Debenham** (farmer and owner). Ray was born and bred here and the farm has been in his family for 3 generations.

We are very happy to welcome you to this lovely small working farm and it is great to be able to share the beauty and tranquillity of this lovely location with you, our guests.

Coopers Farm is an arable farm which mainly grows haylage and hay for horses, but also cereal crops for animal feed. Ray has a great passion for old tractors and steam engines and when he has time, he would be happy to show you around.

I, Janet, am a holistic practitioner specialising in women's health, but I also have several years' experience in holiday rental at my home in southern Spain, and running the small campervan and caravan site here is a job I enjoy tremendously.

We specifically chose to set up the small campervan/ caravan site to accommodate only a handful of guests to be able to offer something simple but special.

Since January 2024 the main field is now a Certificated Location for the Caravan & Motorhome Club, meaning this field is now members-only.

To accommodate those of you who found us direct, Google or camper apps, we have created 4 new pitches at other nearby locations on the farm (2 electric, 2 non-electric). We will let you know where they are at the time of booking.

Another option may be for those of you who would like to return more regularly and want to be on the main field, we would recommend you become a member with the Club which is £59 per year. To help towards the cost of this we can offer you 1 night free when you join. All we would need is your registration number to give you the discount.

We sincerely hope you will have a good time and if you need anything or you encounter a problem, please do let me, Janet, know as soon as possible. I live in the lodge, if the car is there, so am I.

1. Firstly, we are very trusting and believe it is important to welcome you in a relaxed atmosphere. The campsite is set in quiet surroundings and we would like you to be considerate and respect the natural setting of our property and refrain from loud noise and that you take care not to disturb, annoy, endanger, or inconvenience our other guests or our neighbours. 2. We are not checking all the time who is there and who isn't. That would be very annoying. Of course, we may go by for a walk or into the field adjacent for work, but we will not come especially to check things. Since payment is made before arrival, we have a good idea who is coming and going anyway. If you would be so kind to send me a message /Whatsapp to say you have arrived or when you leave and that all is fine, that would be great.

- 3. When you arrive, you will find that the entrance is located in **Lamb's Lane, IP29 4PE**. The gate is unlocked and more than likely open. If not open, please open the gate and come in. Please drive in and choose your place to park up.
- 4. **This CL site** offers pitches for **5 caravans or campervans only**. There are 3 posts each with 2 electric hook ups and a water connection. If you do not require electric, you are free to be near the hedge on the opposite site if you chose to do so.
- 5. Make sure you keep as much space as possible from the next van or caravan to give yourself and the other guests as much privacy as possible. It is also important for your safety in case of fire or gas bottle explosion.
- 6. The campsite is accessible in principle anytime, as long as you make sure you close the gate behind you at night-time when you return. And also respect the fact that people may be asleep. In the evening, we like the gate to be closed when everybody is in for your safety and privacy.
- 7. When leaving the campsite, please leave the pitch how you found it. Make sure you take care of all rubbish. You may be able to make use of my personal black (general rubbish) and blue (recycle) bins when not busy, but there are additional smaller black bins for general waste as well.
- 8. Please, if you could take care of your own glass and tins, we have no facility to recycle them for you. There is a bottle bank just around the corner from the village hall on your right-hand side opposite the post box. If my blue bin has space, tins can be put in there.
- 9. For your holiday we provide you with a grass pitch, water, electric and waste water disposal for the chemical toilet and grey water. NOTE: there are no toilets or shower!
- 10. Please make sure you are ok with using **gas bottles** for your cooking or heating. Please do not put them in hot sunshine.
- 11. **BBQs**. You are more than welcome to use your BBQ conditions allowing. We would like to ask you not to have open fires or BBQs when everything is very dry. In case you deem it safe, then please have some water nearby.
- 12. Be aware that we are in the countryside and that the campsite field, foot paths and around our yard have uneven surfaces with the possibility to fall over, trip etc. Just be careful.
- 13. Be careful with glass, metal or anything sharp falling in the grass for obvious reasons.

- 14. Please make sure you have adequate **holiday insurance cover**, which will refund you in case of the cancellation of your holiday and which will cover your health and your belongings whilst away from home.
- 15. The nearest doctor surgery is either Long Melford or Lavenham. Tel 01787 378226.

- 16. The nearest hospital is on this side of Bury st Edmunds about 15 minutes away. Tel 01284 713000.
- 17. We will only be responsible for the clauses as described above and the things that we provide for you. We would like to strongly express to you that the responsibility of e.g. the use of your equipment like gas bottles, electrical cables and water hoses and any other activities you do on our property is with you as our rental guest.

We cannot be legally responsible for any accidents that may happen on our property, including that of your vehicle during your stay.

18. Fire pit — if you have your own and would like to safely use it, bring it along. In case you need fire wood: we sell small bags of firewood here on the farm at £5 per bag so you can have a nice evening by an outdoor fire. Again, if everything is tinder dry, then please do not use open fires.

You want a straw bale to sit on? Please do let us know.

- 19. **Awnings** we allow awnings but would prefer you **not to use a ground sheet**, it kills the grass quite quickly and would take a long time to recover. This would affect the look of the field and make the pitch look in poor condition. Thank you for your consideration.
- 20. Last but not least: I have 3 cats and a small dog. The cats are especially nosy, so they may come and have a look at you. I would like to ask you to not feed any of the animals, because they are fed a raw diet and they get everything they need from me. Of course, you can stroke them and talk to them

If you are staying with a dog or dogs, please make sure they do not chase the cats and if you could make sure not to foul the camping site.

You can walk the dog(s) on the other side of the hedge along the gravel track and towards the church. You come out at another foot path, left goes back to the road or right through the hedge and along another field. It is not a round walk. You can also walk towards the church with the hedge on the left of you to go to the pub.

There is also a woodland (Golden Wood) a few minutes from the gate in Bury Road. Just go out the gate, turn left, turn right at the crossroads and when you get to a telephone mast near the bus stop there is an entrance to the walk on your left. It is a nice round walk.
